

# Travelling to Kőszeg

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## Those who arrive to Budapest

The most convenient way to travel from Budapest to Kőszeg is to take the InterCity train between Budapest-Keleti Station and Szombathely.

If you arrive by airplane to Budapest-Ferihegy Airport (BUD), you can take the **bus 200E**, direction „**Kőbánya-Kispest M**”. You have to buy two single tickets (2x300 HUF) because you must validate another one when you enter the underground on „Kőbánya-Kispest M” station. You can buy tickets at the newsagents in both of the terminals.

On „Kőbánya-Kispest M” you have to take the **underground M3** (blue line, direction Újpest Központ), then **transfer to line M2** (red line, direction „Örs vezér tere”) at station „**Deák Ferenc tér**” (10<sup>th</sup> stop). At the transfer between the two underground lines you don't have to validate another ticket. You have to get off the underground at station „**Keleti pályaudvar**” (3<sup>rd</sup> stop). The trip between the airport and Keleti station will last about 50-60 minutes.

In case you choose the taxi, we advise you to use the airport's official carrier, Zóna Taxi. You can order the cab at the Zóna Taxi helpdesks in the terminal buildings. The fare between the Airport and Keleti station is 4800 HUF or 22 EUR.

InterCity trains to **Szombathely** leave at 06:10, 10:10, 14:10, 16:10 and the last one at 19:10 from Budapest-Keleti Station and in Szombathely you have to transfer to the local train to **Kőszeg**. The ticket costs 4480 HUF (2<sup>nd</sup> class) and includes the seat reservation what you should not forget to buy!

Bus 200E to Kőbánya-Kispest M (runs in every 10-12 minutes)

Transfer to M2 (red line) at Deák Ferenc tér (10th stop) - direction Örs vezér tere					
Get off at Keleti Pályaudvar (3rd stop)					
Transfer to the IC train to Szombathely

If you arrive on Sunday evening, and you are unable to catch the last train, there's a bus from Budapest-Népliget Bus Station (you can also get there by the M3) to Szombathely, at 21:30, and arrives at 1:00, so in this case, please contact the academic coordinator of International Economic Relations (Anett Horváth) for the transfer to Kőszeg!

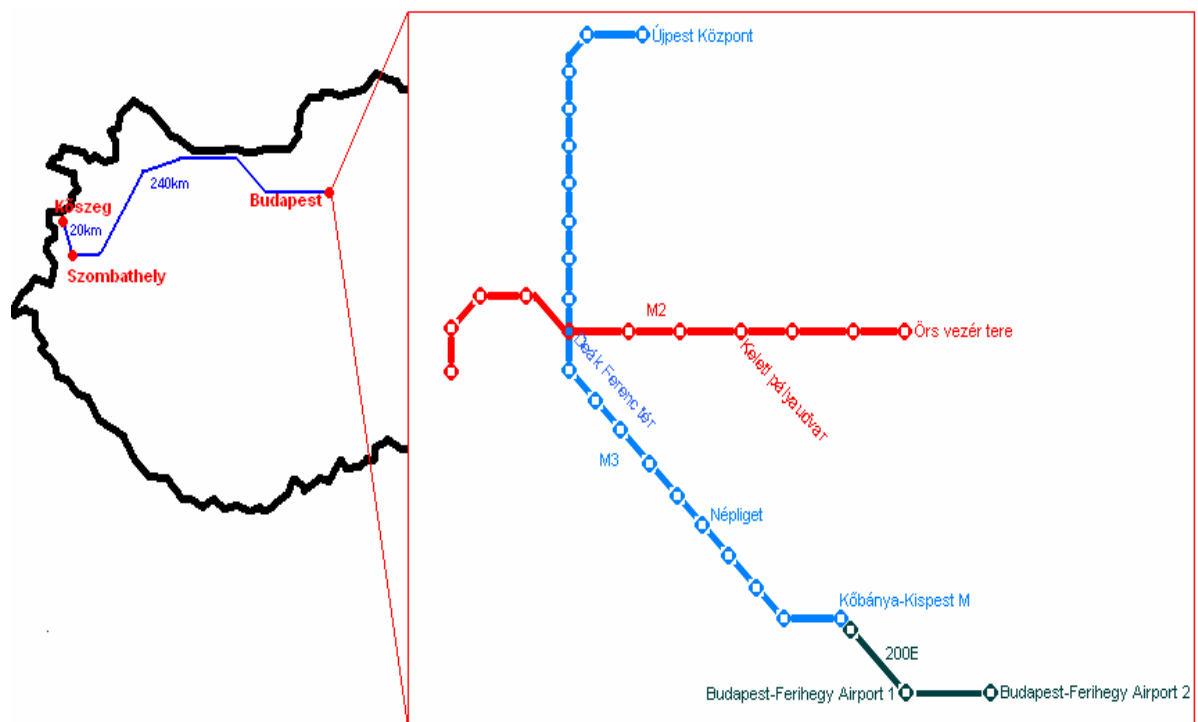

## Those who arrive to Vienna

If you arrive to Vienna by plane you should go to the city by bus which takes you to the railway station Südbahnhof. These buses (Vienna Airport Lines) are leaving in every 20-30 minutes from in front of the arrivals terminal. The fare is 6 EUR. In case you arrive to Vienna by train to Westbahnhof or by bus to Erdberg you should take the underground U3 (orange line) with interchange at Stephansplatz to U1 (red line), direction Reumannplatz. You have to get off the train at station Südtiroler platz (3rd stop) and walk about 300 meters to Südbahnhof. Between Westbahnhof and Südbahnhof you can also go by tram, line 18. Trains to Western Hungary are leaving from Wien-Südbahnhof. Train travellers to Kőszeg have to transfer in Sopron and in Szombathely. Trains between Vienna and Sopron, Sopron-Szombathely and Szombathely-Kőszeg are running frequently on weekdays and in every 1-2 hours on weekends.

On weekdays, you can also catch the bus from Wien-Südtiroler platz (300 meters from Südbahnhof) to a village next to the Austrian-Hungarian border, Rattersdorf, which is about 5 km from Kőszeg. In this case, please contact the academic coordinator of International Economic Relations (Anett Horváth) and she will arrange your transportation to Kőszeg.
